Art in Public Places

We serve as staff to both the Monroe County Art in Public Places Committee, and the City of Key West's Art in Public Places Board. The AIPP Committee is charged with purchase and installation of artwork under a 1% for public art ordinance in any new major county construction or renovation. The Committee is appointed by the Board of County Commissioners. Since passing the 1% ordinance in 2001, \$589,005 has been awarded to 39 public artists for permanent commissioned work. The City's program operates similarly with a board appointed by the Mayor and City Commissioners. Upcoming projects include: Marathon Public Library 2021, Plantation Key Court House 2021 and **Emergency Operations Center 2022.**
