His professional associations include the Palm Beach Young Professionals and the Business Development Board of Palm Beach County. Bowers also serves as a Board member





financial advising and real estate.



Chamber supports one penny sales tax increase

The Chamber of Commerce of the Palm Beaches has joined with other business groups in supporting the local one penny sales tax referendum appearing on the November ballot. The money generated by this one penny increase will be shared by the Palm Beach County School District, Palm Beach County Government and local municipalities. The proceeds will focus on infrastructure needs in our schools, roads, bridges, parks and buildings.

The one penny increase will expire in 10 years or less and all expenditures will be monitored by oversight committees that will include local businessmen and women. Approximately 25 percent of the revenue generated by the one penny will come from tourists and visitors to Palm Beach County.
